Baggage will not be received at pier prior to sailing day, and must be claimed by passenger before it will be placed aboard. A baggage tag or label must be attached to every piece of baggage whether for stateroom or baggage room.

As steamer baggage liability is limited passengers should protect themselves fully against possible loss, damage or pilferage by Baggage Insurance.

You are requested to leave your mail forwarding address with agent at port of embarkation, also at any other port where stop-overs are planned. Globe Wireless will keep you in touch with home and office.

WARNING

Do not give your money or valuables to any person who may approach you in your cabin or on deck claiming to represent the Purser. A safe is provided in the Purser's office where you may deposit your valuables for safekeeping. Secure key of stateroom from Purser, and keep your door locked.



The U. S. Government Sailing Permit Officer, stationed at the gang-plank, requires that the following documents be presented by other than United States citizens:

Persons destined for Honolulu will present ticket as evidence of destination.

Those destined beyond Honolulu will present passport.

Alien passengers will present sailing permit.

It is suggested these documents be readily available for inspection at the gang-plank before boarding your President Liner.

HOW TO REACH PIER

Taxi fare from down-town hotels is approximately 75 cents, or take Third Street car, get off at Southern Pacific Depot (Third & Townsend Sts.), walk three blocks east to pier, or take car No. 28 from Ferry Building to Third & Townsend Sts., or use Municipal Embarcadero Bus Line from Ferry Building direct to pier.
