I suppose if we could raise that \$300 we could go ahead. There seemed to have been some question before as to the royalty. All that can apply on the \$300 until repaid in full. So if any of the Spokane folks cared to make a loan to the Association in that way the matter would be simple enough.

Should the book come out this spring my preface could still be dated from Spokane. I have rather wished it might be a Spokane output, as it would add to the movement being a Spokane idea.

I see the WORLD ALMANAC still has incorrect data on Father's Day. Better get your publicity committee busy to get the matter straight for next year. It ought to be done in a month or so, as they set up some of their items months ahead.
