NOTICE

1. In the presence of imminent military necessities, the authorities concerned will prohibit the journey to the affected area.
2. For any possible risk during his journey, a traveller holds himself fully and solely responsible.
3. Within the Japanese occupied area in North China, a traveller is subject to inspection by the Japanese military authorities and he has to conform to all the regulations enforced by them.
4. Tickets for all means of communication (except tram-cars and city motor-buses) should be obtained on presentation of this permit.
5. This permit should be surrendered to the issuing authorities at the expiry of its term of validity.
6. The loss of this permit should be reported, without delay, to the authorities concerned.
