Day." When "Father's Day" comes to be celebrated all over the land, "mother" will see to it that she is treated in extra fine style for the occasion.

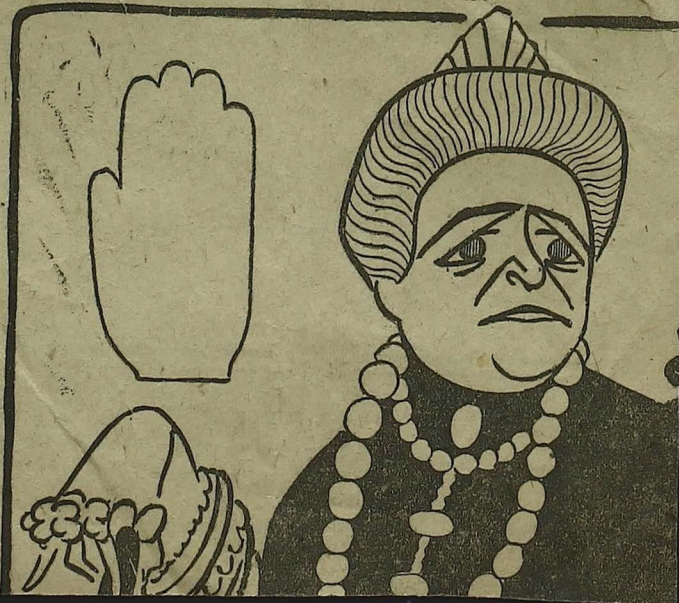
