Dear Mrs. Dodd:-

Your letter of the 24th ult. is at hand, and as Congressman Dill has gone to the conventions I shall reply to your letter as he instructed me. I went to the White House this morning in regard to the matter, and regret to say that it is not probable that the President will be there June 18th. I was informed there that some one could take care of pressing the button providing all the necessary arrangements were made before hand. As you do not state in your letter whether you have made arrangements with the telegraph people or not, I am writing the president of the company asking that this matter be given proper attention. I do not know what the cost, if anything, will be. I shall write you as soon as we hear from them in this regards.

Assuring you of our desire to assist you in every way possible for a successful meeting and with kindest regards, I am,

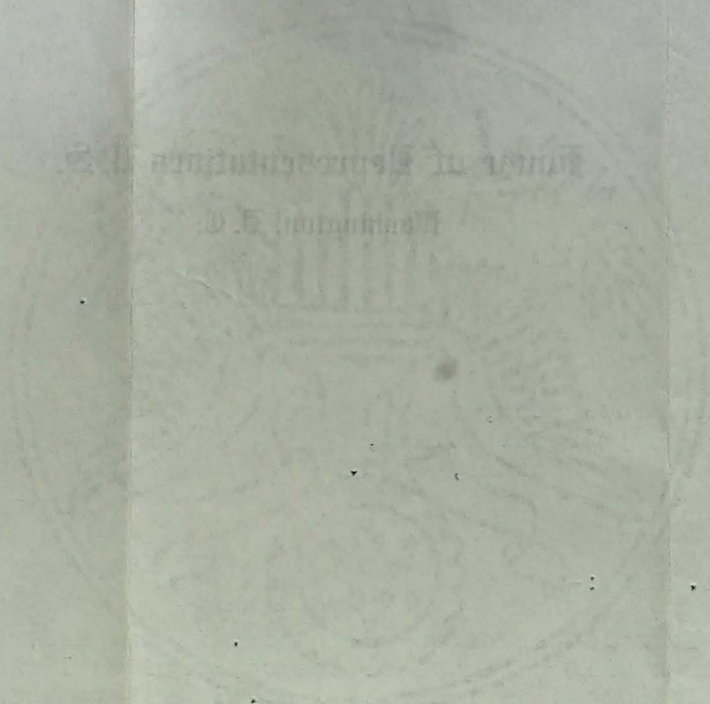

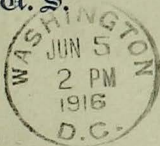
