

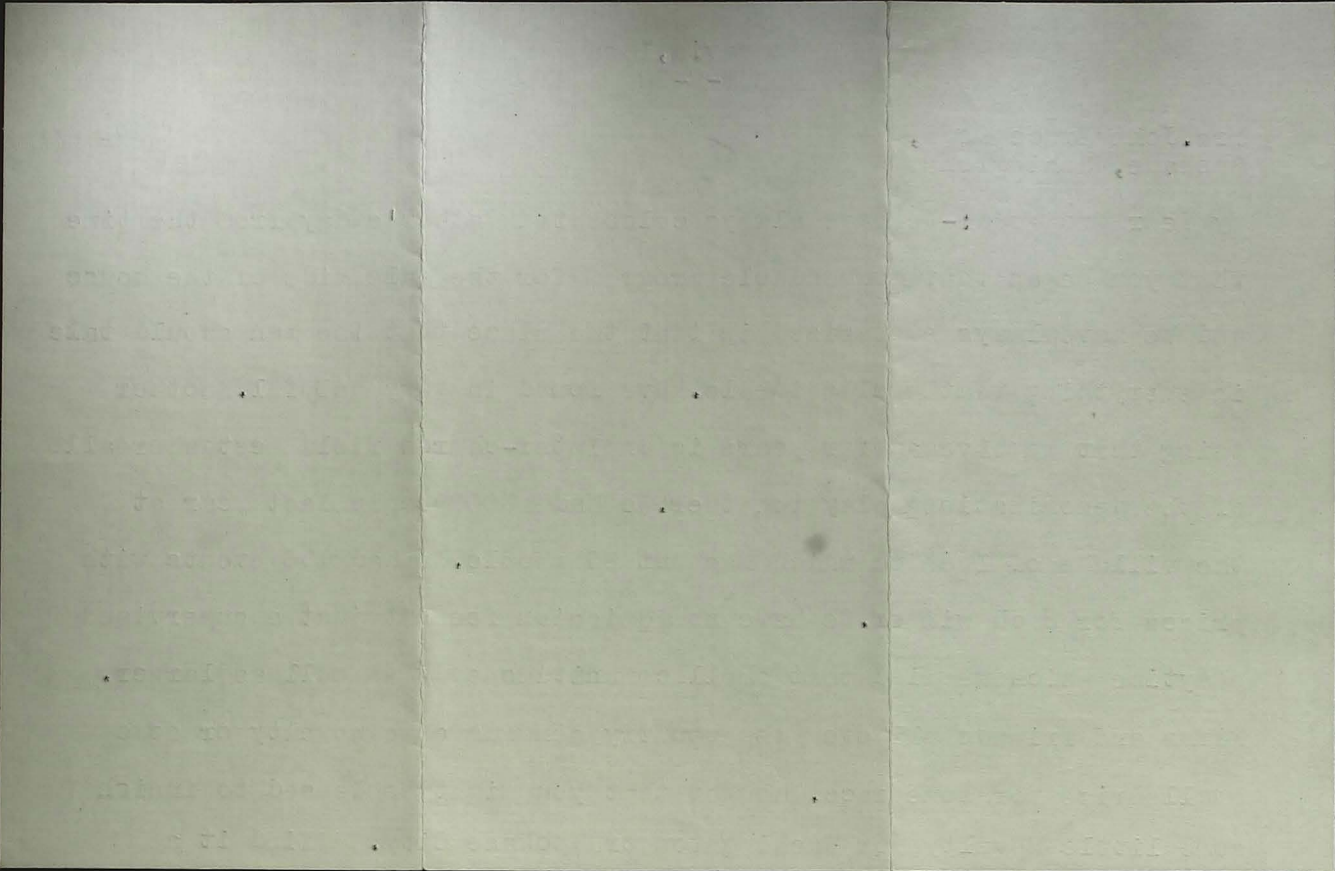
very fine thing in every way. Thanking you and wishing you success in every way, I am
