Singing for evermore, "Alleluia! Amen!"



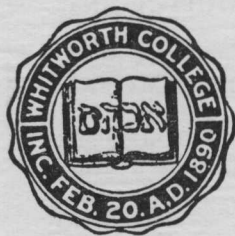
O MASTER, LET ME WALK WITH THEE
