Dear Sirs,

It will make you surprising when you receive this letter. So I must introduce myself to you first. I am one of Miss Hazel Todd's best friends. She led me to believe the Lord in the year 1933. When I was a student of a middle school. My home is at Shucheng, Anhwei. Miss Todd lived there for many years. She also led my mother to be a true Christian. So she was not only a best friend of mine but also my family. Perhaps you remember that you saw my photo and read my letters which I sent to Miss Todd when she returned to home for furlough in the year 1937.

Because of the great war, we have not seen Miss Todd after she came back to China again. But I have received her letters during I studied in the National Chungking

University. Afterwards I came to Kwangsi and Hunan Provinces in teaching in middle schools. I knew Miss Todd has gone to the Lord's home till last year. What a sorrow it was!

I have longed to write to you from that time. But I am sorry to say that I have forgotten your address before I have asked Mr. Dunn of C. I. M. Chungking. Though Miss Todd left us from the world, - and yet she had ever done the good work for God at Shucheng. We shall remember her forever. We Christians have a great joy for we will meet those dead persons again in the paradise.

Now I am teaching in the Jungling Middle School, my wife works with me, too. If you will be glad, we like to be your good friends in Christ.

My mother returned to Shucheng last Sept. She likes to visit Miss Todd's tomb in the Compound often. So you
