
Dear Mrs. Dodd:

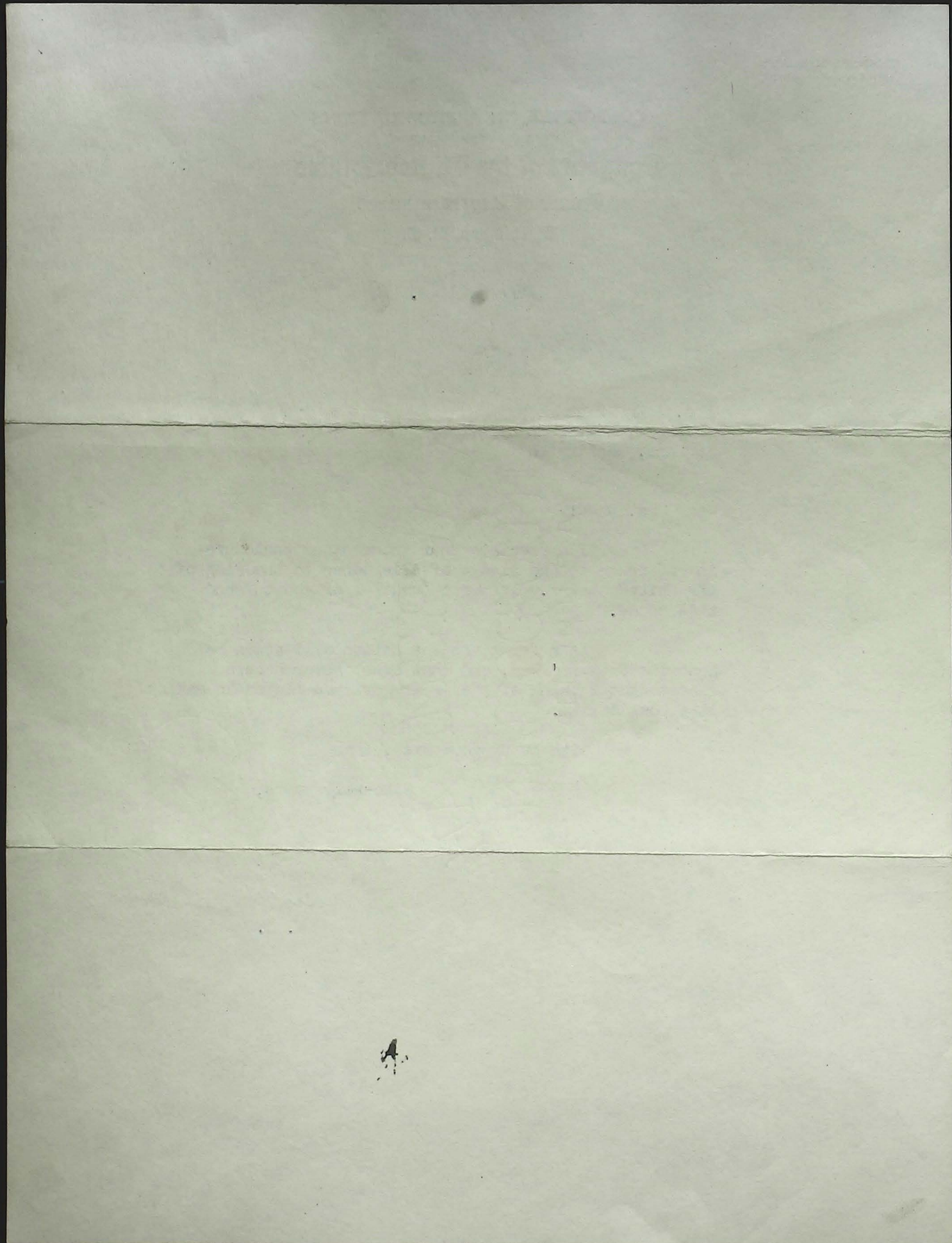
I appreciate your interesting enclosure in reference to the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States. It was thoughtful of you to send this to me.
