P R O C L A M A T I O N

WHEREAS, the third Sunday in June, which this year is June 21, is nationally commemorated as FATHER'S DAY, and observance is especially fitting in the city of its origin:


NOW, THEREFORE, I, David H. Rodgers, Mayor of the City of Spokane, in the State of Washington, do hereby proclaim Sunday, June 21, 1970, to be known as
